1 Samuel 21.10 David fled from Saul and went to Achish king of Gath ... 12 was very much afraid of Achish. 13 So he pretended to be insane in their presence; and while he was in their hands he acted like a madman, making marks on the doors of the gate and letting saliva run down his beard.

<sup>14</sup> Achish said, "Look at the man! He is insane! Why bring him to me? 15 Am I so short of madmen that you have to bring this fellow here to carry on like this in front of me? Must this man come into my house."
