

JESUS CONFRONTS THEIR BELIEFS!

Mark 1:21-22

They went to Capernaum, and when the Sabbath came, Jesus went into the synagogue and began to teach. ²² The people were <u>amazed</u> at his teaching, <u>because</u> he taught them as one who had authority, not as the teachers of the law.

Matthew 5:21-25 "You have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'Do not murder, and anyone who murders will be subject to judgment.' 22 But I tell you that anyone who is angry with his

brother will be subject to judgment ..."

JESUS CONFRONTS OUR BELIEFS.

²³"Therefore if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, ²⁴ leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift. ²⁵ Settle matters quickly ..."

JESUS CONFRONTS <u>OUR</u> BELIEFS.

Matthew 7:43-45

"You have heard that it was said, Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' 44 But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵ that you may be sons of your Father in heaven."

JESUS CONFRONTS OUR BELIEFS.

JESUS' TEACHINGS ARE THE CORNERSTONE OF OUR LIVES!

I Peter 2:4-7

As you come to him, the living Stone—rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to himyou also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 6 For in Scripture it says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame." 7 Now to you who believe, this stone is precious.
