

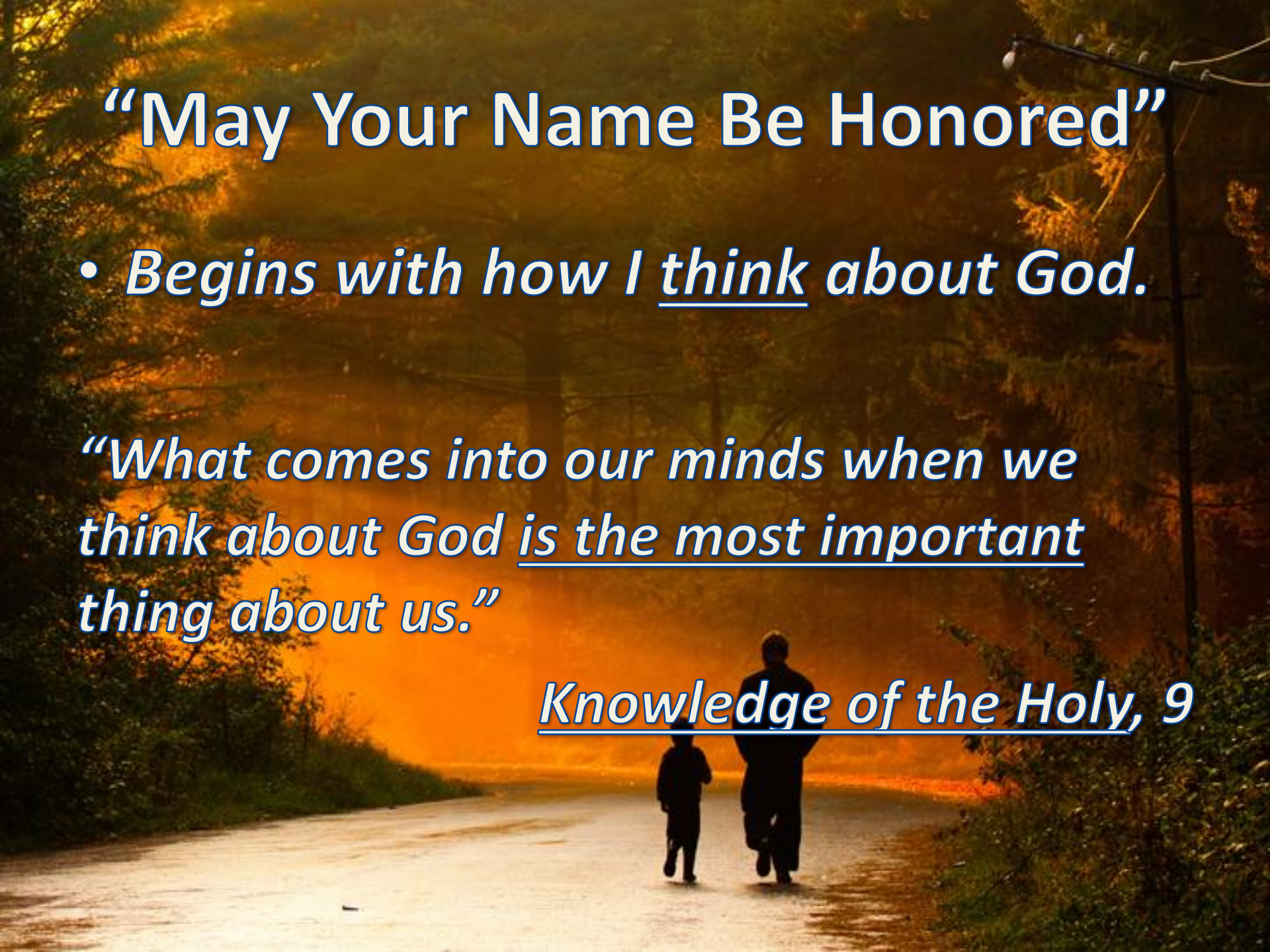


# *“May Your Name Be Honored”*

*“What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us.”*

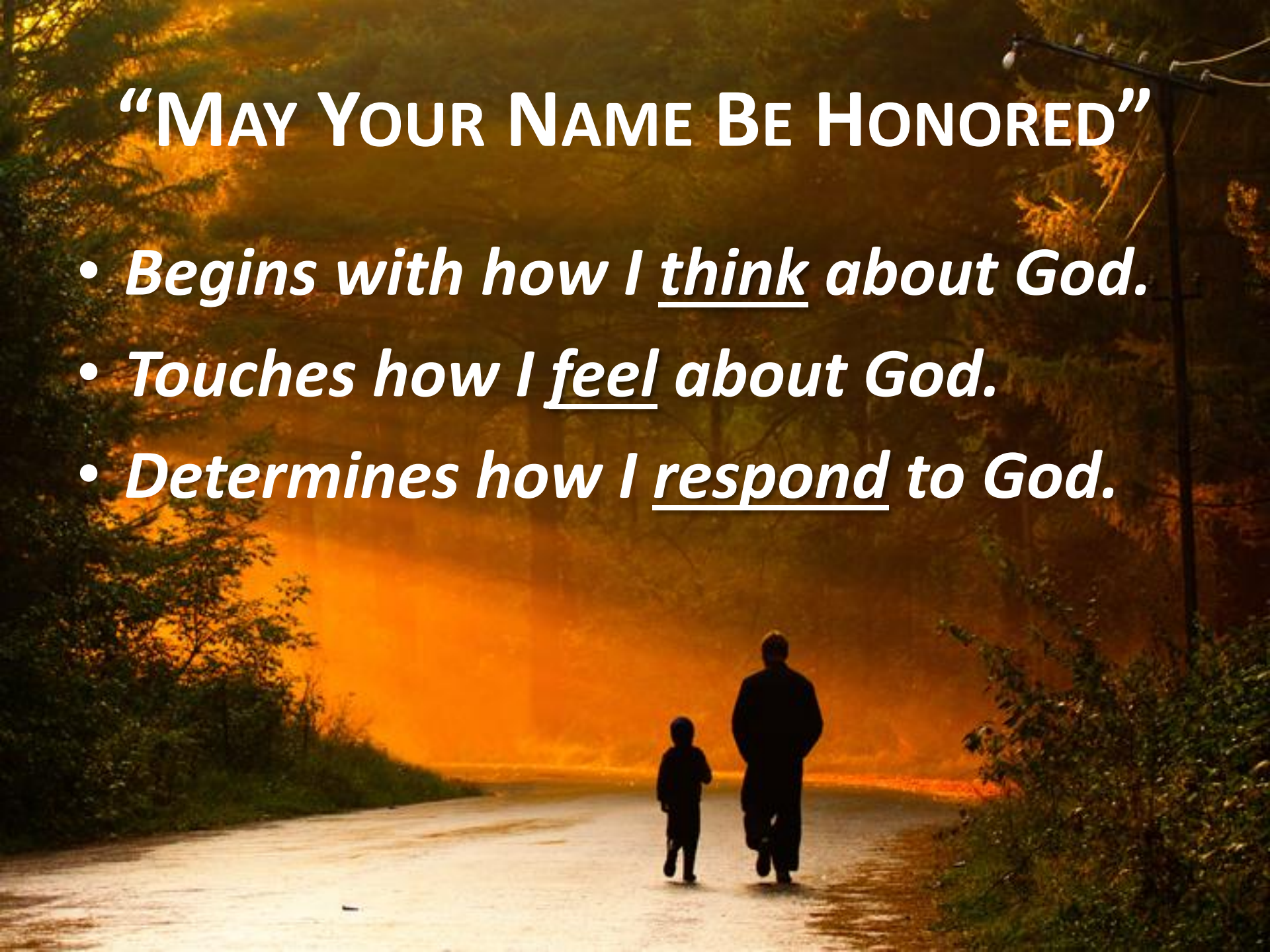

- ***Determines how I respond to God.***






# **“MAY YOUR NAME BE HONORED”**


