

## The Life and Passions of Jesus Christ

#### Mark 4:3-6

<sup>3</sup> Listen! A farmer went out to sow his seed. <sup>4</sup> As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path ... <sup>5</sup> Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. <sup>6</sup> But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root.

#### Mark 4:7 <sup>7</sup> Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and <u>choked</u> the plants, <u>so that</u> they did not bear grain.

### MANY PEOPLE HAVE FICKLE-HEARTED ATTITUDES!


- Worries of this life.
