When It Comes to Confronting Shame, No Victory Goes Unchallenged

Luke 15:20-23

... while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, [and he] threw his arms around him and [he] kissed him ... But the father said to his servants, "Quick! [You go and] bring the best robe and [you] put it on him. [You] put a ring on his finger and [you put the] sandals on his feet. [You] bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's [all of us together] have a feast and celebrate."
