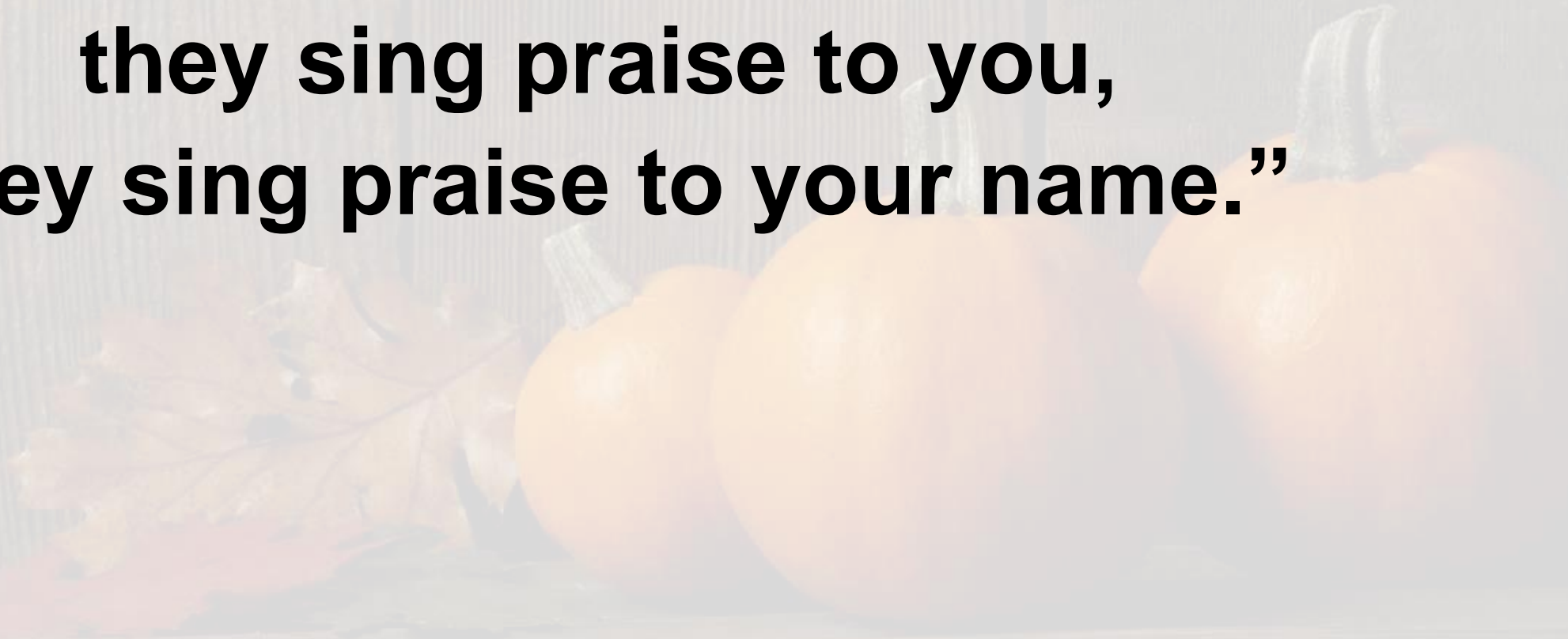

they sing praise to your name.”**

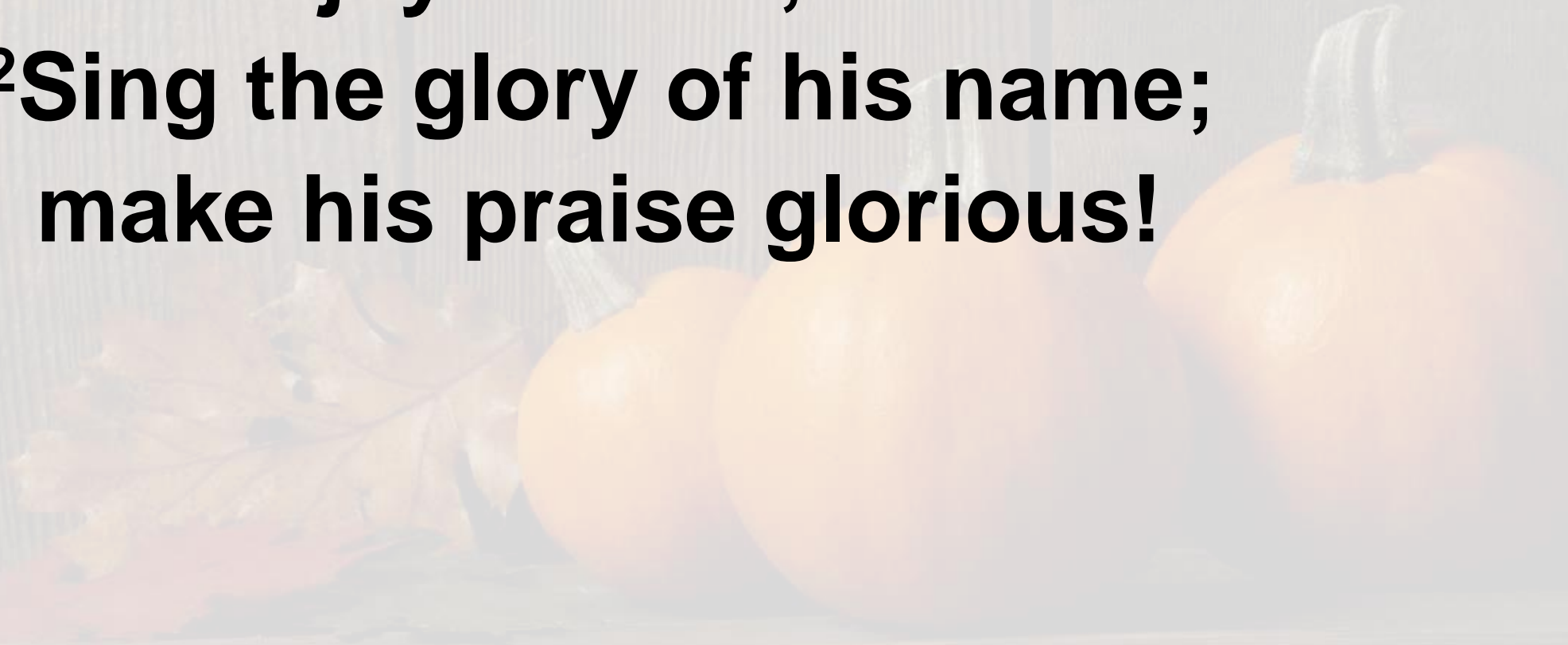

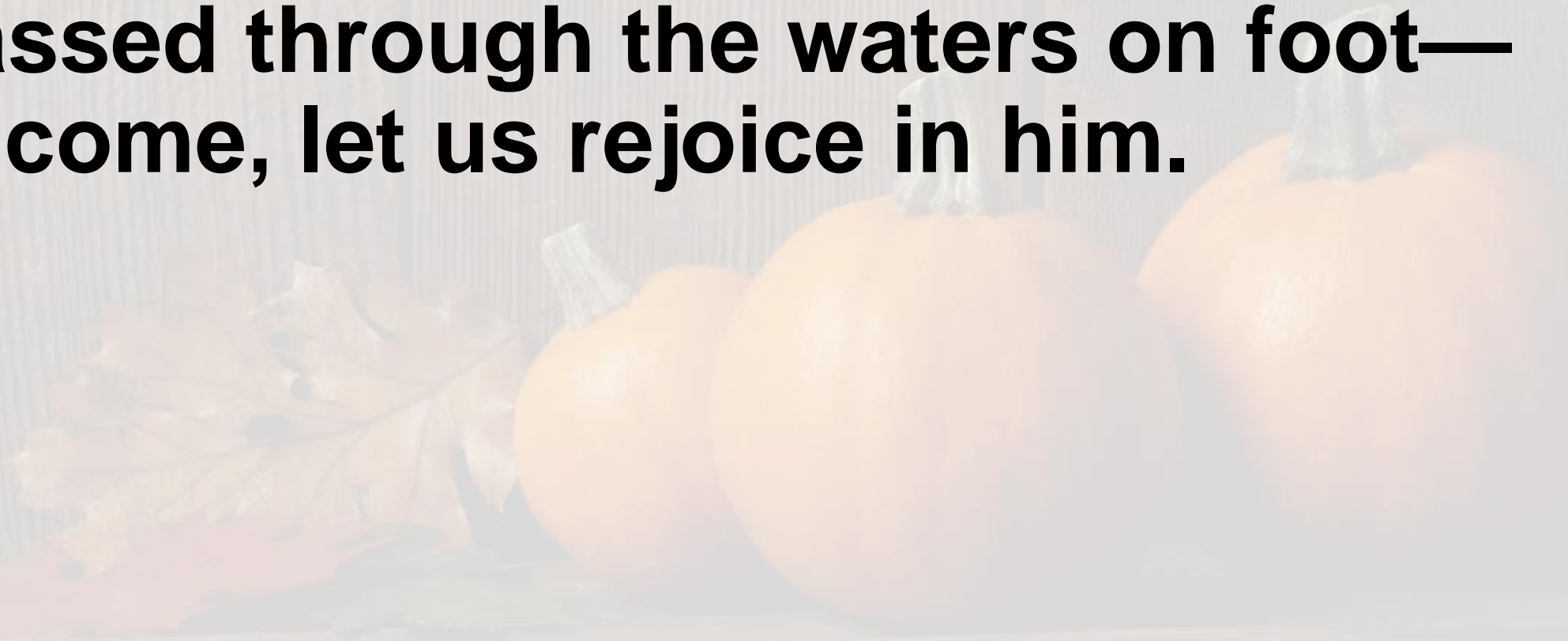
Psalm 66:5 (NIV)


