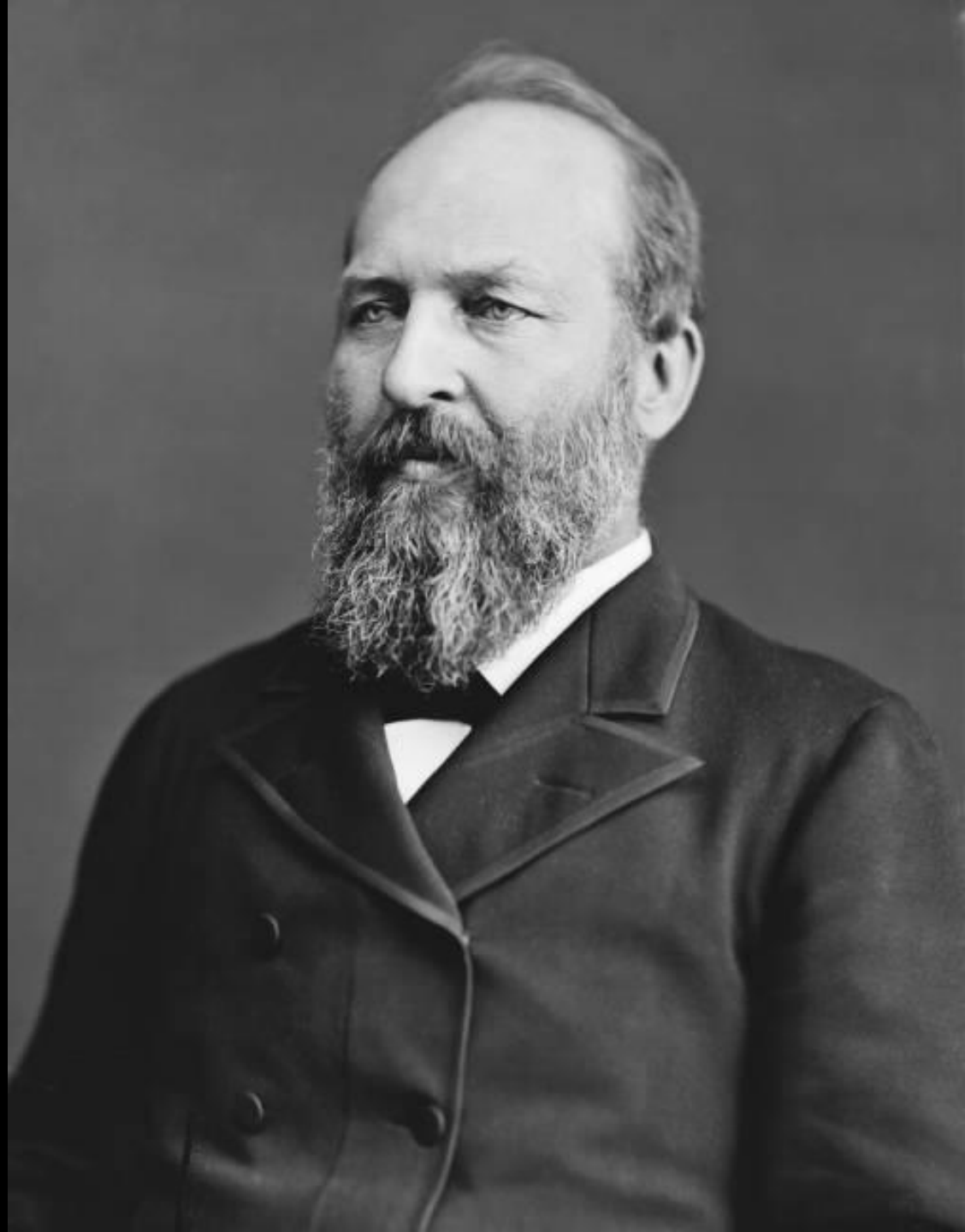

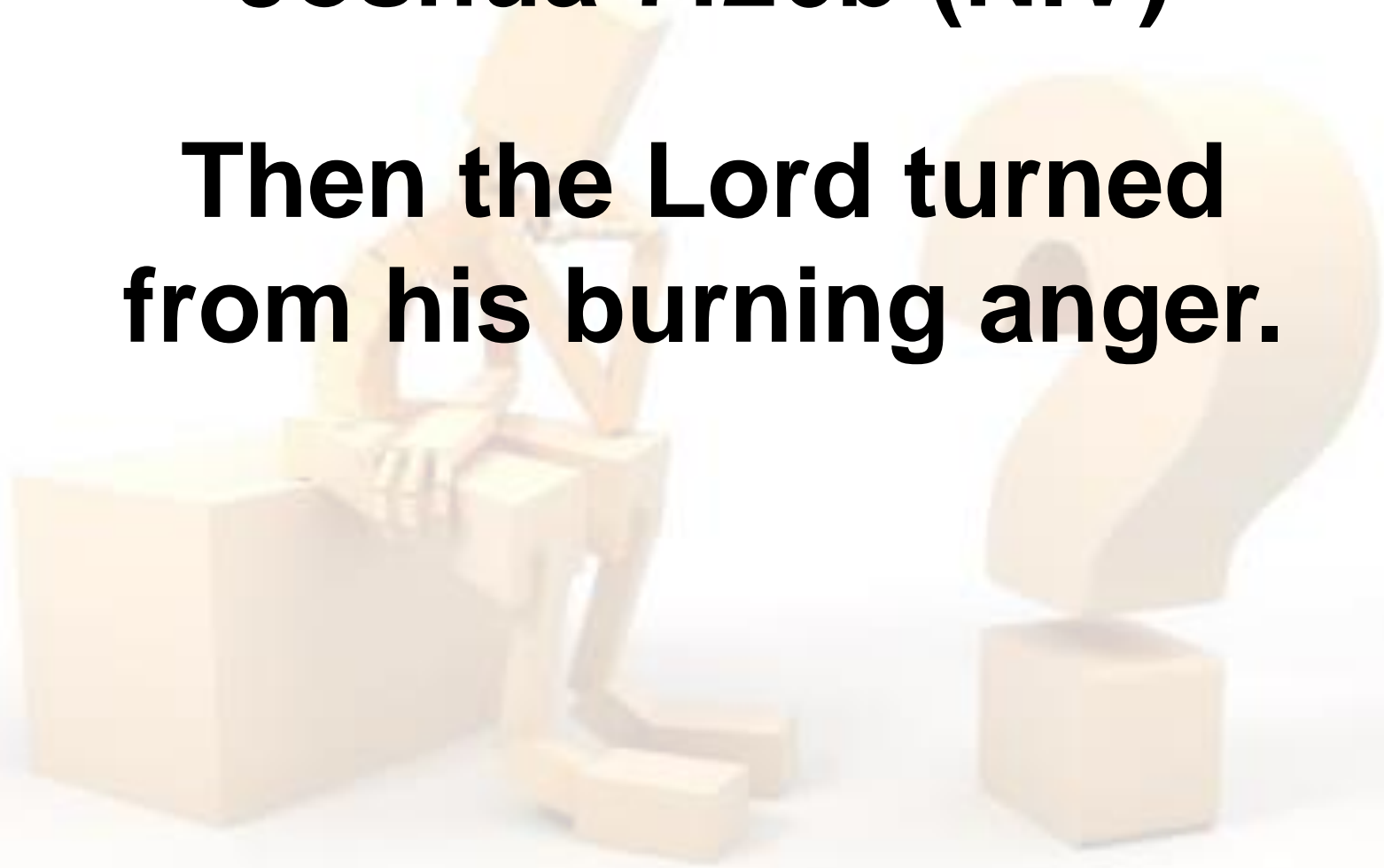
Joshua 7:1 (NIV)




Joshua 7:21 (NIV)
