John 6:15-21 & Mark 4:35-41

There are two types of storm you will experience in this life: the kind you think will kill you & the kind that will simply frustrate you and arrest your progress.

John 6:15-18

15 Perceiving then that they were about to come and take him by force to make him king, Jesus withdrew again to the mountain by himself. 16 When evening came, his disciples went down to the sea, 17 got into a boat, and started across the sea to Capernaum. It was now dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them. 18 The sea became rough because a strong wind was blowing.

John 6:19-21

19 When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were frightened. 20 But he said to them, "It is I; do not be afraid." 21 Then they were glad to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land to which they were going.

FOR THE STORM THAT FRUSTRATES & ARRESTS PROGRESS

- Expect Jesus show up and provide breakthrough.
- Jesus will not abandon those who trust in Him. He will come to us and bring us safely to our destination.
- But when he comes, gladly take him into your boat.

Mark 4:35-38

35 On that day, when evening had come, he said to them, "Let us go across to the other side." 36 And leaving the crowd, they took him with them in the boat, just as he was. And other boats were with him. 37 And a great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking into the boat, so that the boat was already filling. 38 But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion. And they woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?"

Mark 4:35-38

39 And he awoke and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Peace! Be still!" And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. 40 He said to them, "Why are you so afraid? Have you still no faith?" 41 And they were filled with great fear and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?"

FOR THE STORM THAT THREATENS TO KILL US

- Be swamped by the waves of chaos and have no fear no matter how great the storm.
- Jesus is already with you in the boat.
- Lay down. Be still.
