A Mother's Surrender

Mary & Jesus in the Gospels



"Behold, I am the servant of the Lord. Let it be to me according to your word."

"Blessed is she who believed that there would a fulfillment of what was spoken to her from the Lord." (Luke 1:45; ESV) "But Mary treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart." (Luke 2:19; ESV) "Son, why have you treated us so? Behold, your father and I have been searching for you in great distress." (Luke 2:48; ESV) "Why were you looking for me? LESSON # 1 - Your kids are first and foremost God's, not yours. They came from God and ultimately belong to God. His claim upon them is primary; yours is secondary.

"When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus said to him, 'They have no wine.' And Jesus said to her, 'Woman, what does this have to do with me? My hour has not yet come.' His mother said to the servants, 'Do whatever he tells you.'" (John 2:3-5; ESV)

LESSON # 2 - Don't try to rush God. Things won't happen on your timetable; they'll happen on his. "Then he went home, and the crowd gathered again, so that they could not even eat."

(Mark 3:20; ESV)

"And when his family heard it, they went out to seize him, for they were saying, 'He is out of his mind.'" (Mark 3:21; ESV)

"And a crowd was sitting around him, and they said to him, 'Your mother and your brothers are outside, seeking you.' And he answered them, 'Who are my mother and my brothers?" (Mark 3:32-33; ESV)

"And looking about at those who sat around him, he said, 'Here are my mother and my brothers! For whoever does the will of God, he is my brother and sister and mother."

(Mark 3:34-35; ESV)

LESSON # $\overline{3}$ - The road God has assigned for your kids to walk may be painful and costly. It's likely not the path you would choose. Instead of trying to shield your child from walking with the Lord through the valley of the shadow of death, choose to trust God. Pray you both will be faithful to do God's will at every turn.
