





# Behind Closed Doors

### Luke 12:35-37



## Luke 12:42-45

42 "Who then is the faithful and wise manager, whom his master will set over his household, to give them their portion of food at the proper time? 43 Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes. 44 Truly, I say to you, he will set him over all his possessions. 45 But if that servant says to himself, 'My master is delayed in coming,' and begins to beat the male and female servants, and to eat and drink and get drunk..."

### Luke 12:46-48

46 "The master of that servant will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he does not know, and will cut him in pieces and put him with the unfaithful. 47 And that servant who knew his master's will but did not get ready or act according to his will, will receive a severe beating. 48 ... Everyone to whom much was given, of him much will be required, and from him to whom they entrusted much, they will demand the more."  Does my faith and witness have a healthy effect—either hot or cold—on those who live around me?

 How would Jesus assess my spiritual state? Would His perspective differ sharply from my own? What would He identify as my deep needs? • Can I recognize ways in which my friendship with the world has render me ineffective for God's kingdom purposes?

• How might I be locking Jesus out of my life? How might we being preventing Jesus' entry into and leadership within His church?
