Mt 6:25-34

"For this reason I say to you, do not be worried about your life, as to what you will eat or what you will drink; nor for your body, as to what you will put on. Is life not more than food, and the body more than clothing?

Look at the <u>birds of the sky</u>, that they do not sow, nor reap, nor <u>gather</u> crops into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more important than they?

And which of you by <u>worrying</u> can add a single day to his life's span?

And <u>why</u> are you worried about clothing? Notice how the lilies of the field grow; they do not <u>labor</u> nor do they <u>spin</u> thread for cloth, yet I say to you that not even Solomon in all his glory clothed himself like one of these...

...But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, will He not much more clothe you? You of little faith!

But <u>seek first His kingdom</u> and <u>His righteousness</u>, and all these things will be provided to you."
