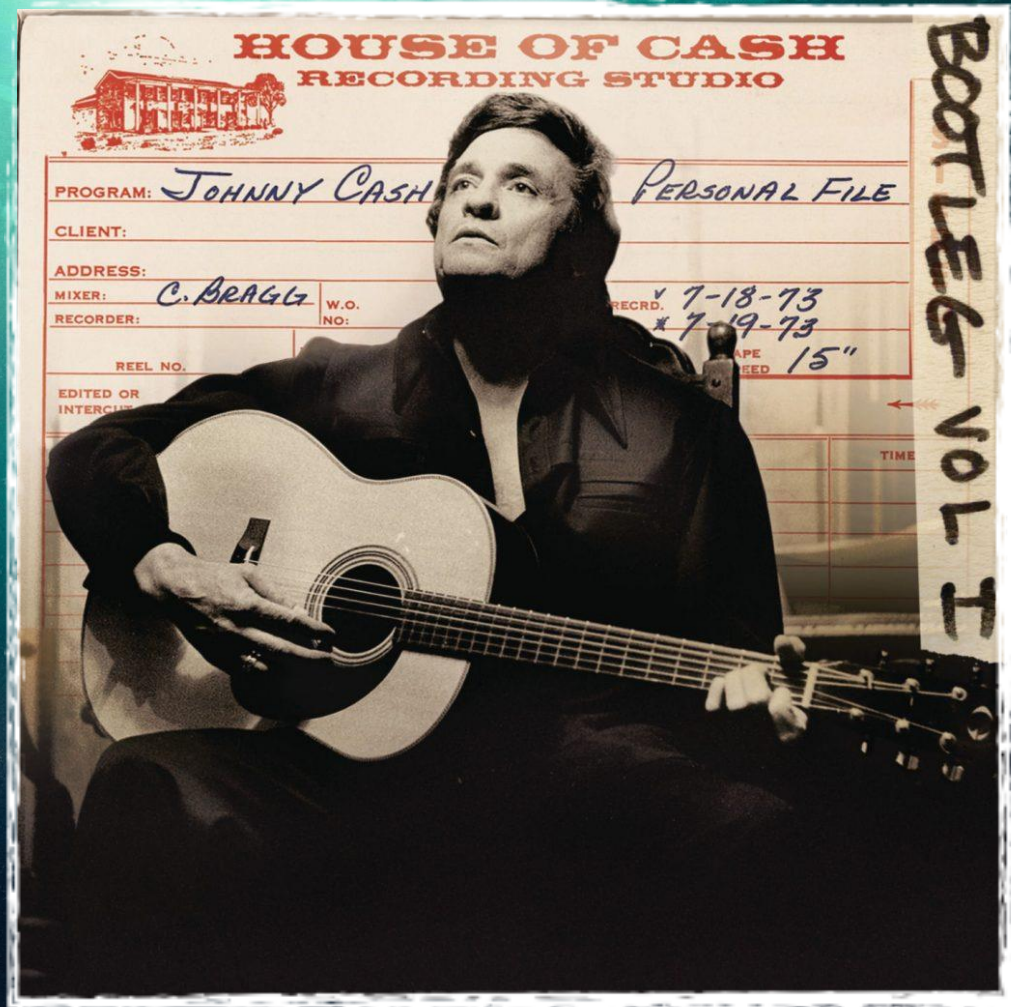


“No Earthly Good” (1977)


Jonah 1:11-12




