James 1:27

God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him... 21 And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also.

implore you to walk in a manner worthy
of the calling with which you have been
called, with all humility and gentleness,
with patience, showing tolerance for one
another in love...

4:17-19

So this I say, and affirm together with the Lord, that you walk no longer just as the Gentiles also walk, in the futility of their mind, being darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart; and they, having become callous, have given themselves over to sensuality for the practice of every kind of impurity with greediness.
