WHERE IT ALL BEGAN

Deuteronomy 11:18-19 (ESV)

18 You shall therefore lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 19 You shall teach them to your children, talking of them when you are sitting in your house, and when you are walking by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

Deuteronomy 11:20-21 (ESV)

20 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, 21 that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers to give them, as long as the heavens are above the earth.


"In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth."

The primary focus of God's creation account is to share with us His WHY and to help us understand our PURPOSE and ROLE in relation to Himself and the universe He has made.

"All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made." (John 1:3)

"In heaven and on earth, visible and invisible... all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together." (Colossians 1:16-17)

Before God there was nothing. From nothing God made all that is.

Genesis 1:2 (ESV)

2 The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

In the watery dark, even in what appears like <u>CHAOS</u>, God is present, active, and sovereign.

The TASKS OF CREATION:

- Separating & setting apart
- Assigning roles & functions
- Naming (speaking identity over)
- Installing & empowering partners

Genesis 1:3-5 (ESV)

3 And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. 4 And God saw that the light was good. And God separated the light from the darkness. 5 God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, the first day.

On Day 1, God creates TIME.

Genesis 1:6-8 (ESV)

6 And God said, "Let there be an expanse in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters." 7 And God made the expanse and separated the waters that were under the expanse from the waters that were above the expanse. And it was so. 8 And God called the expanse Heaven. And there was evening and there was morning, the second day.

On Day 2, God creates LIVING SPACE and WEATHER.

Genesis 1:9-10 (ESV)

9 And God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear." And it was so. 10 God called the dry land Earth, and the waters that were gathered together he called Seas. And God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:11-12 (ESV)

11 And God said, "Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, and fruit trees bearing fruit in which is their seed, each according to its kind, on the earth." And it was so. 12 The earth brought forth vegetation, plants yielding seed according to their own kinds, and trees bearing fruit in which is their seed, each according to its kind. And God saw that it was

Genesis 1:13 (ESV)

13 And there was evening and there was morning, the third day.

On Day 3, God creates a stable, sustainable FOOD SUPPLY.

Genesis 1:14-15 (ESV)

14 And God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night. And let them be for signs and for seasons, and for days and years, 15 and let them be lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light upon the earth." And it was so.

Genesis 1:16-19 (ESV)

16 And God made the two great lights—the greater light to rule the day and the lesser light to rule the night—and the stars. 17 And God set them in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth, 18 to rule over the day and over the night, and to separate the light from the darkness. And God saw that it was good. 19 And there was evening and there was morning, the fourth day.

On Day 4, God deputizes the SUN, MOON, and STARS to be His emissaries in the HIGH HEAVENS.

Genesis 1:20-21 (ESV)

20 And God said, "Let the waters swarm with swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the expanse of the heavens." 21 So God created the great sea creatures and every living creature that moves, with which the waters swarm, according to their kinds, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:22-23 (ESV)

22 And God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth." 23 And there was evening and there was morning, the fifth day.

On Day 5, God deputizes the BIRDS and the CREATURES OF THE SEA to be His emissaries in the realms of SKY and SEA.

Genesis 1:24-25 (ESV)

24 And God said, "Let the earth bring forth living creatures according to their kinds livestock and creeping things and beasts of the earth according to their kinds." And it was so. 25 And God made the beasts of the earth according to their kinds and the livestock according to their kinds, and everything that creeps on the ground according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

On Day 6, God creates a diverse variety of CREATURES to fill the LAND with life and deputizes HUMANITY to be His special emissaries to all creation.
