Job 19:19-20

Job- “All my intimate friends detest me; those I love have turned against me. ²⁰ I am nothing but skin and bones; I have escaped only by the skin of my teeth.”

Job 5:8

Eliphaz- “But if I were you, I would appeal to God; I would lay my cause before him.”

6:25

Job-“How painful are honest words? But what do your arguments prove? 26 Do you mean to correct what I say, and treat my desperate words as wind?”

Job 8:5-6

Bildad- “But if you will seek God earnestly and plead with the Almighty, if you are pure and upright, even now he will rouse himself on your behalf and restore you to your prosperous state.”
